Through donations of money, food, clothing, gifts, toys, and personal care items, JCCB provides necessary assistance to Clients at an annual Holiday Shop every December. People are referred from SRS, Catholic Charities, schools, churches and other agencies.

In 2009 the number of low income served in Johnson County:

Total Number of Families = 2,855

Total Number of Individuals = 10,387

*72% served were women and children
